Garden Etiquette

The Alaska Botanical Garden is a private non-profit garden dedicated to plant education, preservation, research, and recreation. The Garden is open to the public, and relies on program fees, memberships, donations, and entrance revenue to operate – we receive no Federal, State, or Municipal operating support.

Admission to the Garden is \$7 per person, \$5 per child ages 3 - 18
Admission is free for ABG Members and children under 3.

General Garden Etiquette (Rules):

Adherence to the following guidelines is required of all Garden visitors. Please help us preserve a safe, peaceful, and friendly atmosphere, and a secure habitat for our plants and wildlife, by heeding these few simple rules:

- No smoking.
- No pets.
- No motorized vehicles, except work vehicles in areas permitted by staff.
- No parking or waiting vehicles in the ABG driveway – please use the Benny Benson School parking lot across the entrance drive.
- “Leave no trace” – take everything you brought into the Garden out with you when you leave.
- No food or food trash permitted in the Garden, except with staff permission in the Nursery / Gift Shop area.
- Remain on the pathways at all times. Do not step into planting beds or on any garden infrastructure (rocks, walls, benches, etc.)
- All children under 16 must be accompanied and supervised by an adult.
- No harvesting, collecting, or removal of plant material, seeds, fruit, fungi, feathers, wild animals, birds, rocks, etc.
- Do not disturb or move plants, signage, plant labels, or containers.
- Do not feed, harass, or approach any wild animal. Please report all bear, moose, lynx, etc. sightings to Garden staff.
- Do not block access to the entrance, pathways, or garden areas for use by others.
- Skating, skateboarding, rollerblading, kites, balls, portable stereos, and frisbees are not permitted.
- As a courtesy to other garden visitors, please refrain from loud noises, screaming, etc.
- All facility rentals, weddings, photography sessions, events, and classes must be pre-scheduled and paid through the Alaska Botanical Garden Office or Gift Shop during regularly scheduled hours.
